The Bike Room invites you to *Tie Dyes on the Sunrise*, a solo exhibition featuring new work by Karolina Gnatowski. Gnatowski creates physically rich, bodily works that operate through a psychedelic lens turning textures, colors and woven structures into wall-hung protagonists and other strange characters. Working against the backdrop of such craft traditions as the Bauhaus, Gnatowski confronts these ideals through surface embellishment and pop culture iconography from the 1960s and 70s.
